

Course Syllabus: Kallis Institute SAT Crash Course

Course Overview:

The SAT Crash Course introduces students to the SAT and to the types of questions they can expect to encounter on the exam. Students will have the opportunity to prepare for the SAT by taking 4 practice tests in a highly competitive environment. Kallis Institute's comprehensive course will give students the tools they need to achieve success on the SAT.

Course Objectives:

Students in the SAT Crash Course will:

1. Familiarize themselves with the format and content of the SAT.
2. Refresh mathematics and language skills covered on the SAT.
3. Master reading strategies to maximize comprehension.
4. Build awareness of all question topics on all sections of the SAT.
5. Discover effective analysis strategies to improve SAT Essay scores.
6. Prepare for the SAT in a proctored, standardized testing environment.

Course Materials:

Kallis' *SAT Pattern Strategy* and *Key to the SAT* are required for the course. The cost of these materials has been included in the course fees. Enrollment in Kallis Institute includes access to KallisPrep.com, Kallis' premier online SAT preparation platform.

Instructor:

Chris Lee has been teaching and creating instructional materials for SAT preparation course for three years. He is an expert on test trends and analyzing question topics. On the old SAT, Chris received a 2260.

Class Sessions (M/W/F 3:30 - 6:00 PM):

Class is held on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 3:30 to 6:00 PM. Please note that class will let out at 6:30 PM on the first and last days. Each class, students will take a section test to gain valuable testing experience. In addition, a structured lecture over specific testing topics will give students insight into specific question types and how to approach each one.

Proctored and Take-Home SAT Practice Tests:

The most important part of any preparation course for the SAT is practice. Therefore, Kallis Institute proctors two full-length practice tests and offers students ample opportunities for skills practice in the classroom.

Office Hours (3:00 - 3:30 PM):

To help our students get the most from the SAT Crash Course, we will be holding office hours before the start of each class. Students can ask questions and receive additional guidance during this time.

Homework:

In addition to proctored practice examinations and quizzes, students are expected to complete daily homework assignments. All homework is assigned on KallisPrep, unless otherwise noted. See the assignment calendar to access each lesson's homework. After completing each assignment, please take a minute to review your score report. Score reports and answer explanations provide valuable insight into your strengths and weaknesses, allowing you to address any difficulties. Homework should be completed following the class session during which it was assigned.

Grading:

All in-class tests and quizzes will be graded by the instructor and returned the following class session. Homework is graded automatically on KallisPrep.com and available immediately for student review. In addition, a customized scoring report will be emailed to students and parents one week after completion of the course. This report will show pretest and posttest scores as well as overall improvement.
